

38th ROSKRUGE OPEN CROSS-COUNTRY MEET

Time: 11:00 A.M. (walk-thru on your own)

General Instructions:

1. There will be four races: One for boys in sixth-grade and below. One for girls in sixth-grade and below. One for boys in eighth-grade and below. One for girls in eighth-grade and below. Sixth-graders may compete in either race, but may not compete in both races. Seventh- and eighth-graders may only compete in eighth-grade and below races.
2. Walk-thru is on your own. The eighth-grade and below girls race will begin at 11AM followed by the eighth-grade and below boys race. (At the starter's discretion, the races for 8th-grade and below runners may begin simultaneously.) The sixth-grade and below girls race will then follow, followed by the sixth-grade and below boys race. (The course for the sixth-graders and below is 1 mile. The course for the eighth-graders and below is 2 miles.)
3. **Sixth-graders may compete in the 1 mile race, however, their places cannot figure in the team scoring. Only fifth-graders and below may make up the team score for this portion of the meet.**
4. Place ribbons will be awarded to top 25 finishers in the sixth-grade and below divisions. Top five runners will receive a trophy. Top 10 ribbons will be awarded in the eighth-grade and below divisions. Top runner will receive a trophy. ALL OTHER FINISHERS FROM ALL RACES will receive participation ribbons. 1st-Place teams in all divisions will receive a trophy. 2nd- and 3rd-place teams in the 5th-grade and under portions of the meet will also receive a trophy.
5. **No entry fee will be charged.** All runners must wear a tag with name, grade, and school. Name tags will be available free at Palo Verde. Please print neatly and provide **first and last** names and **school**.
6. Scoring rules:
 - A) Each race will be scored separately.
 - B) The top five finishers for each team will comprise that team's score.
 - C) A team must finish at least five runners in order to score.
 - D) A team may enter an unlimited number of runners.
 - E) A runner's actual finish will be the place figured in comprising the team score. ("Bumping" will not be used.)
 - F) No tie-breaking procedures will be used for team places.
